### **BUILDING LOCAL CAPACITY TO CREATE GLOBAL OPPORTUNITIES**

Recognising that Information Communication Technology (ICT) is an enabler for economic growth and noting the diverse challenges in the Pacific region in relation to access, availability and affordability, there is a need to strengthen capacity in the policy arena, improving Internet and Telecommunications infrastructure, encourage local content creation and innovation through a clear development strategy.

It is critical that youth in the Pacific are given opportunities for training and education in these areas, in order to empower communities through driving local innovation, helping next generation leaders to understand the ICT ecosystem and its connection to the global economy.

This Youth Tech Camp is an opportunity to learn how to innovate and become part of a larger network of youth engaged in ICT. With dual opportunities for participants to gain a greater understanding of ICT and Internet Governance issues, as well as practical skills in local content creation through mobile app development, this Youth Tech Camp will build local capacity to create global opportunities.

### **ICT & INTERNET GOVERNANCE**

In pre-PACINET sessions, participants will obtain a basic understanding of ICT and Internet Governance. They will also be empowered to engage intelligently with Internet Governance issues in Forums such as the PACINET or Internet Governance Forum (IGF) in local, national, regional and international settings.
